DCP Research Award

Purpose: Recognize recent contributions from faculty members to the literature and their field of study and encourage future quality research

Evaluation Criteria:

- Performance in the past 5 years
- Evidence of distinguished achievement in scholarly activity
- Evidence of genuine innovation and valuable results for the research community
- Evidence of a strong research agenda that is likely to lead to continuing distinction in the scholar's field
- Visibility within and beyond the university

Eligibility: DCP faculty, nominee cannot have won a DCP/UF research award in the past 3 years

Nomination: Nominations from chairs or directors, 1 nomination per unit

Application: 1-2 page memo summarizing scholar's research and planned future research, list of collaborations, publications (refereed journals, refereed proceedings, non-refereed publications), Impact Factors of publications, conference presentations, reviews, media releases, and activities within professional organizations related to the field of study. Do not include thesis or dissertations.

Frequency: 1 award per year

Judge: DCP awards committee with Associate Dean for Research. Awards committee will provide a recommendation for the Dean. Dean will make a final decision.

Award: Monetary award of \$300.00; Plaque to individuals; Recognition at DCP Faculty and Staff Awards
