DCP Undergraduate Faculty Teaching Award

Purpose: Recognize faculty members for their outstanding teaching performance of undergraduate students

Evaluation Criteria:

- Evidence of continued outstanding teaching performance with undergraduate students
- Strong evidence of undergraduate student success and excellence (awards, competitions, publications, scholarships, etc.)
- Undergraduate teaching evaluations for past 3 years
- Letters of support from undergraduate students

Eligibility: All DCP faculty and lecturers teaching undergraduate students, not be a prior winner of the DCP Undergraduate Faculty Teaching Award

Nomination: Nominations may be submitted by students, faculty, and staff. The winner of this award will go on to represent DCP for the UF Teacher of the Year award.

Application: Nominees need to submit a 1 page (max) statement describing their teaching philosophy, 3 letters of support from previous or current students, a list of courses taught, 1 page narrative letter of nomination clearly identifying the outstanding qualities of the nominee

Frequency: 1 award annually

Judge: DCP Awards Committee will provide a recommendation for the Dean. Dean will make a final decision.

Award: Monetary award of \$200.00; Certificate; Recognition at DCP Faculty and Staff Awards
